

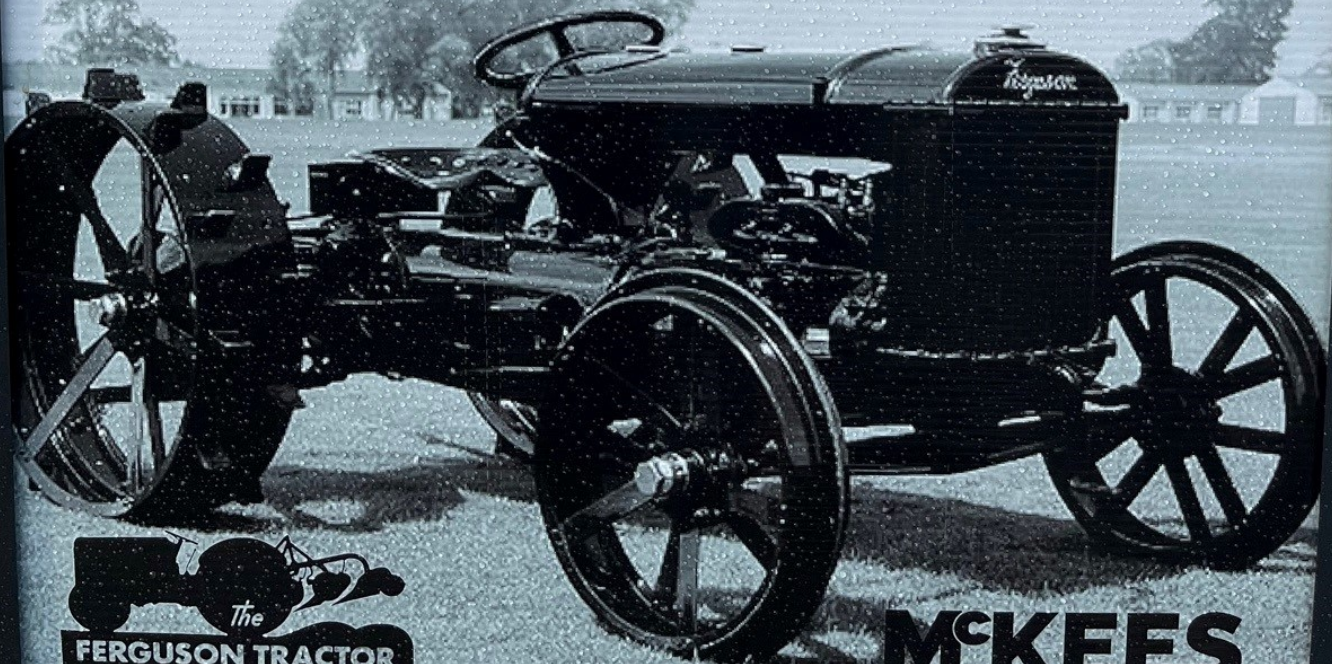
90 *Years* OF THREE POINT LINKAGE

Harry Ferguson - Inventor & Pioneer.

He was the first Irishman to Build & Fly His own aircraft in 1909, but by far his most notable achievement was the development of the Ferguson System three point linkage system.

Harry and his team started out in 1917 to improve the mounting & performance of mouldboard ploughs and other implements when used with tractors instead of draught horses.

After 16 years & various adaptations in 1933 the very first Ferguson prototype tractor (the Black tractor) was built with the Ferguson System, this alone was one of the greatest leaps forward in the history of mechanised agriculture.
